## ITEM 5 - CONSENT CALENDAR

Director Glancy moved the approval of the consent calendar. Director Nila seconded the motion. The minutes and list of disbursements were unanimously approved.

#### ITEM 6 - STATUS REPORT ON ARRA-FUNDED CATCH BASIN PROJECT

Ms. Kast reported that the release of the retention to the contractor was scheduled for February 21<sup>st</sup> barring any Stop Payment Notices. She also reported that all closure statements had been completed with the State Water Resources Control Board. Ms. Kast concluded by stating that the single audit was still underway and was due to the state by March 31, 2012.

#### ITEM 7 – STATUS REPORT ON IRWMP ACTIVITIES

Mr. Bill Bennett reported that GEI is working with their sub-consultant on developing the public outreach plan. He indicated that after his review over the next few days, he would be sending it to Ms. Kast for her review. He also reported that they are still collecting data for the water balance calculations and thanked everyone for their assistance. In addition to this work, they have been also working on preparing for the first stakeholder's meeting scheduled after the board meeting to be held in the same room at 1:30. He concluded by stating that contingent upon finalizing the draft public outreach plan, the first IRWM public meeting was tentatively scheduled for February 29<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at this same location.

#### ITEM 8 – CITY MANAGER'S STEERING COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Farfsing reported on recent membership meetings he attended with the Executive Officer. He reported that they had met with La Habra Heights and the La Habra Heights County Water District as well as the City of Artesia. At this time, it did not appear that La Habra Heights was in a position to join. He indicated that they have scheduled a meeting with Montebello on February 14<sup>th</sup>. The plan is then to schedule meetings with Compton, Huntington Park and Maywood.

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Ms. Kast reported that the City of Bell is interested in joining but is requesting that the dues for the current year be waived while they plan to include them in their budget for their next fiscal year. The board requested that this request and any other requests be agendized in March.

Mr. Farfsing then reported that he along with Mr. Wattier attended a study session which included Jeff Kightlinger of MWD and Grace Chan of the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles to discuss reclaimed/recycled water needs.

Ms. Farfsing updated the board on the draft LA County Parcel Fee Ordinance. He then requested that Mr. Phil Doudar of the LA County Flood Control provide additional information. Mr. Doudar indicated that the County's legal and finance/treasurer departments are reviewing the ordinance to ensure it is consistent with their requirements.

## ITEM 9 – REPORT FROM PROP 84 STORMWATER GRANTS AD HOC COMMITTEE

Ms. Kast reported that five applications had been submitted to the State Water Resources Control Board for Prop 84 Stormwater grants. She referred to a handout summarizing each of the applications.

## ITEM 10 - EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

Ms. Kast referred to an article Mr. Mostahkami had requested be distributed to the board regarding the State Water Resources Control Board's recent approval of a water quality restoration strategy for the ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles to address hazardous toxic chemicals. The article stated that cities that directly discharge stormwater into the waters of the two ports would be required to comply in order to ensure they are not contributing to the existing contamination.
