ITEM 5 – MEASURE W - GATEWAY WATERSHED AREA STEERING COMMITTEES (LOWER LOS ANGELES AND LOWER SAN GABRIEL)

In November of 2018, LA County voters voted in favor of Measure W, the Safe Clean Water Program, which is a parcel tax that would increase Los Angeles County's local water supply, improve water quality, and invest in making communities greener and more livable.

Mr. Matthew Frary from Los Angeles County Flood Control District provided a presentation regarding Measure W's Implementation Schedule. There are three programs, totaling in the amount of approximately \$300M annually, to be implemented: Regional, Municipal, and Flood Control District. Mr. Frary reviewed the anticipated timeline for implementation of the three programs.

Mr. Richard Watson, of Richard Watson & Associates, provided a presentation of the Gateway Region Watershed Area Steering Committee Membership and Role. Mr. Watson reviewed the steering committee structure in relation to WMP/EWMP Participation. The Committee will have 17 members, with each member having one equally weighted vote. There will be: seven seats designated for municipalities located within the watershed area, five seats for agency stakeholder representatives, and five seats for community stakeholders. Each member
