The following questions and answers pertain to the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for General On-Call Professional, Technical and/or Engineering Services that was released on Wednesday, July 26, 2023.

1. Q: Due to the uncertain nature of specific task orders under an on-call contract, may selected consultants add additional subconsultants as needed during the contract term?

A: Yes.

2. Q: Is the requirement to list “at least five (5) references/clients” on page 3 of the RFQ a different and separate request from the requirement to list “a minimum of five (5) relevant projects” in the “Relevant Project Experience and Client Reference” heading on page 4 of the RFQ?

A: They are the same. Provide five relevant projects your firm or personnel have completed in the last five years. For each of those projects, provide project description, year(s) of performance, client name and contact person with telephone number and email address

3. Q: Please clarify the statement on page 4 of the RFQ that states: “Mileage rate cannot exceed current IRS rate” Does the current IRS rate refer to the 2023 rate or whatever the current rate is when the mileage is driven?

A: “Current IRS rate” is the rate at the time when the selected on-call consultant is requested to provide a proposal for a specific project.
